Here's everything you need to know to make your holiday the best yet!



TYPES OF GLAMPING

At Stanley Villa Farm, we offer two different types of glamping: Bell Tents and Pods. Both come with their own firepit and include access to all onsite facilities. Read more about each one below, or for full details and availability, head to our website, stanleyvillafarm.co.uk



We have 10 Bell Tents, all the same in size. Each comes with a double bed & mattress and a double futon bed. Additional airbeds can be hired if required. Bell Tents sleep 2 adults (max.) and up to 3 children.

All Bell Tents come with a wood burning stove inside to keep you toasty warm. Stove packs are available from the onsite shop.

Bell Tents are not pet friendly.

HOT TUBS

Bell Tent number 1 and Pod number 1 both include wood-fired hot tubs, for those looking for a more luxurious experience.



WHAT TO BRING

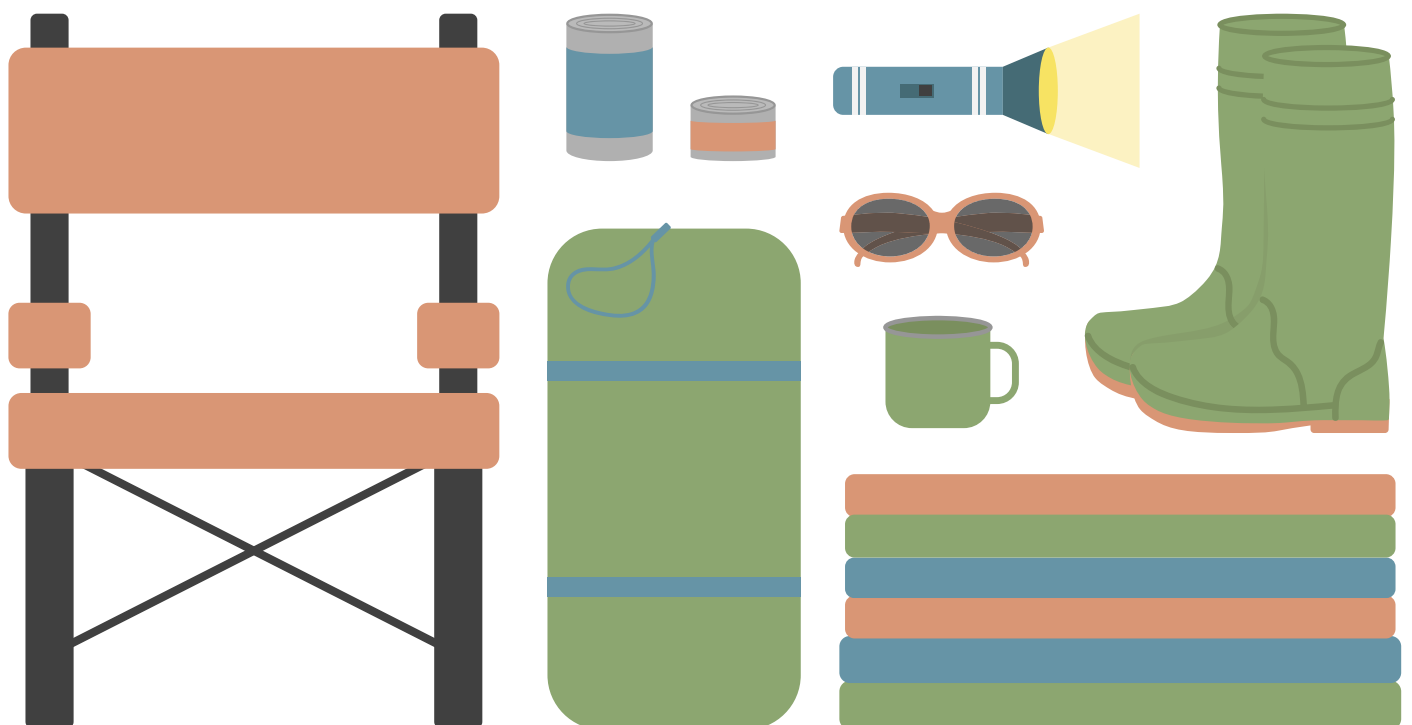
Everything that you'd normally bring on a camping trip except the tent. The most important thing to remember is your bedding (e.g. an under sheet, sleeping bags/duvets and pillows).

In a Pod - you'll need to bring additional airbeds if bringing children; alternatively, you can hire airbeds for £5 each.

You'll need to bring your own food and drink - although we do sell tea, freshly ground coffee and luxury hot chocolate, as well as crisps and snacks. Fridge/freezers are available to use in the main lodge.

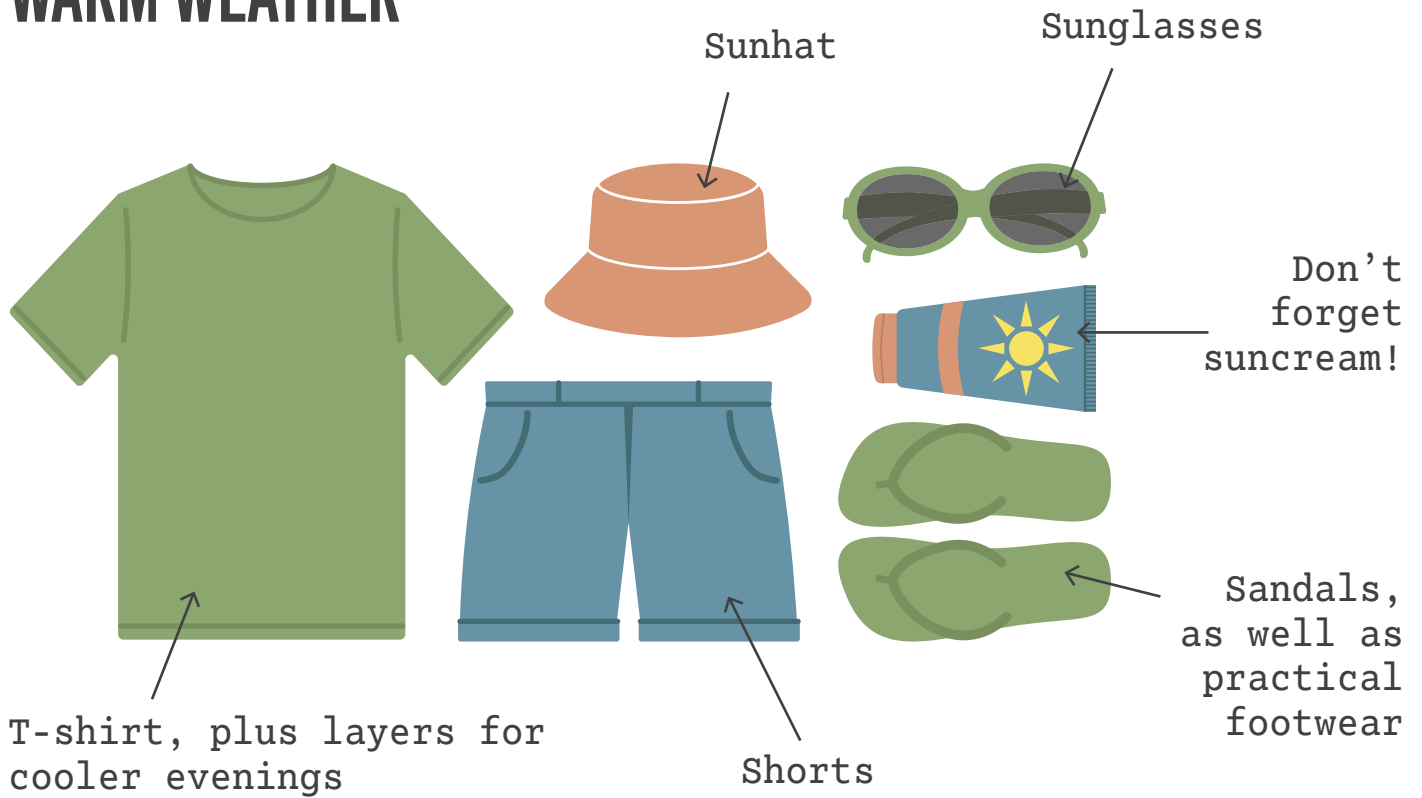
Outdoor chairs are handy to bring so you can sit around the campfire, although you can hire them on arrival for £3 per chair (for the duration of your stay).

A torch is a good idea as well.

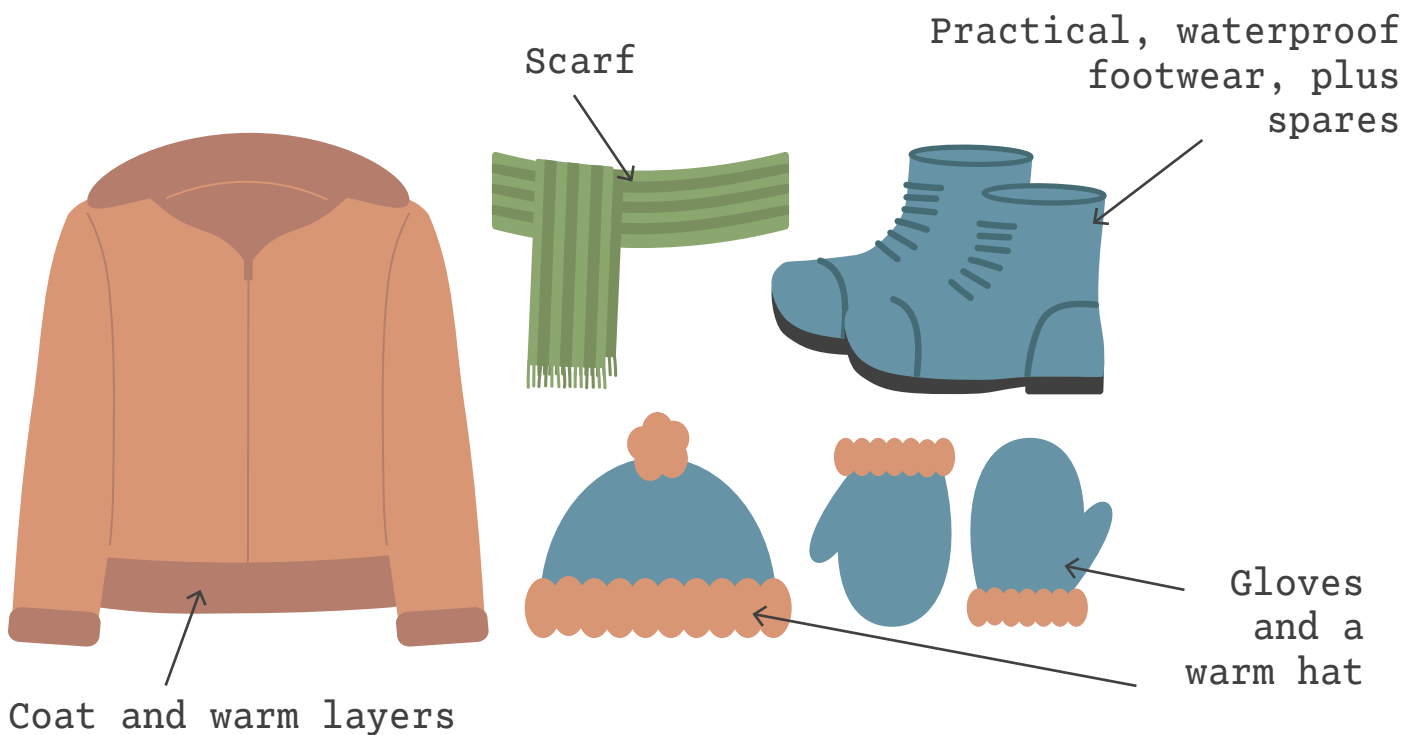

We're all aware of the unpredictability of the British weather, so be sure to check the forecast before you come, and pack suitable clothes. The postcode to check the weather for is PR4 3HN.

We have a noise cut off time of 9.30pm, there is strictly no music past this time and conversation must be kept to a sensible level. We also ask that you don't sit outside past 11pm, security will ask you to head in to your Pod/Tent if you do. This ensures that everybody gets a good night's sleep.

Our onsite shop sells delicious local ice cream and a wide selection of treats including sweets, marshmallows, hot chocolate, toys, and games, as well as firewood for the firepits.



COMMUNAL AREA/KITCHEN

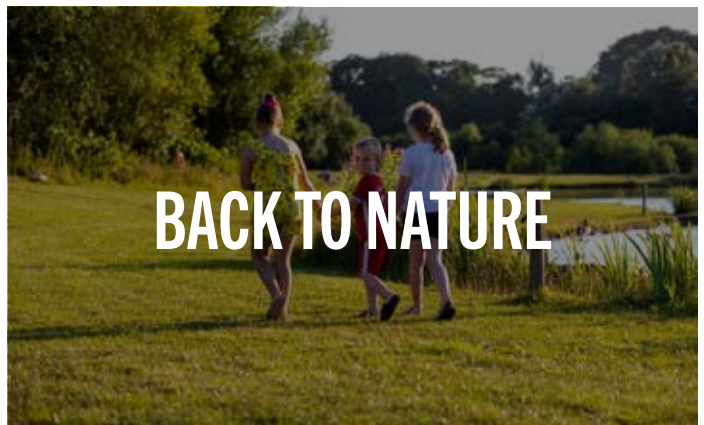
Inside our main lodge we have a large seating area with tables and chairs, ideal for families or couples to eat their meals. We have fridges and freezers where guests can store their food, as well as a kitchen area including a microwave, a toaster and a kettle. Outside the lodge we have picnic benches where you can enjoy a beautiful panoramic view of the lake.

We also have three wet rooms with sparkling clean showers and toilets.
